Arrival is any time after 3.00 pm on the day of booking, departure must be by 10.00 am. Please let us know if you are likely to arrive very late.

The booking is for short term holiday rental only and the cottage must be vacated on or by the agreed departure date. The number of persons occupying the cottage must not exceed the number on the booking form.
